The Williamsburg City Council met in Regular Session August 13, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. at the Williamsburg City Hall.

Mayor Roddy Harrison declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

I. Approval of June 18, 2012 Regular Council Meeting Minutes and June 20, 2012 Special Council Meeting Minutes.

A motion by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember Stanfill to approve the June 18, 2012 Regular Council Meeting Minutes and June 20, 2012 Special Called Council Meeting Minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

II. Floor Business

Dr. John Duke came before council with a request to officially close an unused, unnamed street near Lakeview Lane in Highland Park.

Mayor Harrison appointed a committee of Councilmember West, Councilmember Foley and Councilmember Stanfill to review the request.

Greta Price, City Attorney stated that if the committee recommends closure of the road, then adjacent property owners must be notified and an ordinance requiring two hearings would have to be passed. If there were any objections to the road closure, then a public hearing would be held.

III. Proclamation in support of Win the War against Violence

Mayor Harrison presented a proclamation in support of Win the War against Violence, which is an educational campaign targeting Kentucky youth.

A motion by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember Sharp to approve the proclamation of Win the War against Violence. All voting aye, motion carried. It will be held August 20th – 24th at Williamsburg City Hall.
