III. Historical Society

Mayor Harrison recommended that city council deed the old L & N Railroad Depot to the Whitley County Historical Society and Genealogical Society, which is where the historical society has been since 2005. Mayor Harrison said that the building had been owned by the University of the Cumberland, which recently deeded the building over to the city as part of a land swap of the old Williamsburg-Whitley Rescue Squad building and property. The building and property were deeded to the city after the Williamsburg-Whitley Rescue Squad became defunct several years ago. The Historical Society and Genealogical Society have wanted to obtain the depot building for quite a while, so they could make improvements to the building.

A motion by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember Connell to accept the deed of the old L & N Railroad Depot from the University of the Cumberland and approve donating the Old L&N Railroad Depot to the Whitley County Historical Society. All voting aye, motion carried.
