I. Approval of may 10, 2010 Regular Council Meeting Minutes

II. Floor Business

Fast Cash Pawn Shop owners and employees came before council to express their concerns about certain provisions in the Pawn Shop Ordinance. Two concerns were the security cameras inside the store and that they keep written records of who purchased what items from the store.

Council agreed to table the second reading of the ordinance pending a meeting between Williamsburg Police Chief Wayne Bird, Allan Trimble, Commonwealth Attorney and the Pawn Shop Owners.

III. Second reading Pawn Shop Ordinance #10-02

A motion by Councilmember Hamblin and seconded by Councilmember Riley to table the second reading of the Pawn Shop Ordinance until next month's Council Meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

IV. First reading of the Budget Ordinance #10-03 for the City of Williamsburg for the Fiscal Year 2010-2011

Mayor Harrison read a summary of the Budget for the Williamsburg Tourism Commission and the City of Williamsburg for the fiscal Year 2010-2011.

Greta Price, City Attorney read the first reading of a Budget Ordinance #10-003 of the City of Williamsburg for the Fiscal Year 2010-2011. Second reading will be on June 24, 2010 at 3:00 p.m.

V. Municipal Road Aid Cooperative Contract and Resolution for the Fiscal 2010-2011

A motion by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember Hamblin to approve the Municipal Road Aid Cooperative Contract and Resolution for the Fiscal Year 2010-2011. All voting aye, motion carried.

Councilmember West

-would like to commend the Police Department on their professionalism during the meeting with the Fast Cash Pawn Shop owners

-concerned with the dip in the road on the south bound lane of 25W near Campbell Hill

-stated that people are breaking into the blighted property on 484 North 11th Street and the roof is falling in on 494 North 11th Street

-asked if something could be done with the speeding on Croley Bend Road
