III. Discussion of Flood Levee Certification

Mayor Harrison announced that the Federal Emergency Management Agenda is requiring all flood levies to be recertified by September 2015. This means hiring either a civil engineer or paying the Army Corps of Engineers to do it. Mayor stated it could cost the city as high as \$100,000. The city has to show that our flood levy can withstand a 1 percent chance of a 100 year flood. The certification process will take about five months to complete and FEMA has indicated that no extensions will be granted. If the recertification isn't done and there is a flood that breaches the levy, then the city would lose its flood insurance rating. Mayor stated there might be some grant money out there to help pay for part of costs.
