APRIL 8, 2013**

The Williamsburg City Council met in Regular session on April 8, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the Williamsburg City Hall.

Mayor Harrison declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

**I. Approval of March 11, 2013 Regular Council Meeting Minutes**

A Motion by Councilmember Sharp and seconded by Councilmember Harris to approve the March 11, 2013 regular council meeting minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

**II. Floor Business**

Wayne Bird, Police Chief, told council that the police department recently purchased a "data box" which can be mounted to telephone poles to monitor speeds in a particular area. The first targeted area for the new data box will be Cumberland Avenue. Mr. Bird stated this box will collect speed data on the street and will graph it out. It will also measure the traffic flow on those particular streets.

Mr. Bird announced that the department is adding a second K-9 unit. Officer Jason Strunk will go for training next month and then hit the street with the new patrol dog, which is trained in drug detection, tracking and criminal apprehension. The dog was purchased using money from the department had set aside along with donations from Butch's Market, Whitley County Coroner Andy Croley and generous donation from the University of the Cumberlands.

Mr. Bird also stated that the two dogs the department received from the military last year are strictly explosive sniffing dogs and not patrol dogs.

**III. Resolution/Municipal Order No. Series 2013**

A resolution/municipal Order of the City council of the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky, authorizing the issuance of its educational facilities revenue improvements bond, series 2013 ( University of the Cumberlands, Inc. Project) in the aggregate principal amount of up to \$3,000,000 ( The "Bond"). for the purpose of financing the cost of, and reimbursing the University of the Cumberlands, Inc., a Kentucky non-profit corporation qualified under internal revenue code section 501(c)(3) (The "University"), for costs already incurred in connection with, the acquisition of parcels of real property and improvements located within the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky to be used for the development of athletic fields, the expansion of the football field, the development of a new Boulevard into the campus of the University, and for other educational purpose of the University; providing for a pledge and assignment of revenues to the payment of said bond; authorizing the execution and delivery of a bond purchase and loan agreement; designating the bond to be "Bank Qualified" under section 265 of the internal revenue code; and taking other related actions. A motion by Councilmember Sharp and seconded by Councilmember Harris to approve the Councilmember Foley abstaining. Mayor Harrison voting yes. Motion carried.

**IV. First reading of an ordinance establishing Zoning Changes for the City of Williamsburg.**

Mrs. Greta Price read the first reading of an ordinance # 13-005 establishing eight zoning changes, which were recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission.  
Second reading will be at next month the May 13, 2013 meeting.

**V. Adjournment**

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Councilmember Harris and seconded by Councilmember Foley. All voting aye, motion carried.
