II. Second reading of an Ordinance closing the street Whitley Avenue

Mayor Harrison read the second reading of an Ordinance closing the street Whitley Avenue.

Mayor Harrison stated that the street was created in 1911 and they couldn't find a record of where the road had been officially closed. The city was asked to close the road so that a portion of the property can be sold to a business interest, which hopes to locate there creating 45 new jobs.
