Mayor Harrison declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

I. Approval of October 13, 2014 Regular Council Meeting Minutes.

A motion by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember West to approve the October 13, 2014 Regular Council Meeting Minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

II. Floor Business

Mr. Russell Jones, former police officer of the City of Williamsburg received a certificate from the Kentucky House of Representative, signed by State Representative Regina Bunch and House Speaker Gregory Stumbo, recognizing his courage while under fire during 1981 incident when he was a Whitley County Sherriff's Deputy.

III. Williamsburg RV Park

Mayor Harrison told council that the City of Williamsburg hopes to open a 17 site RV park adjacent to the Kentucky Splash Waterpark, which will be complete with water, sewer, electric and cable TV hookups in addition to wireless internet.

A motion by Councilmember Sharp and seconded by Councilmember West to authorize Mayor Harrison to sign documents for a \$275,000 loan, which would pay for construction for the new RV Park. All voting aye, motion carried.

Mayor Harrison stated the Williamsburg Tourism Commission has agreed to cover the loan payments for the first year of the project if the park doesn't generate enough revenue from renting RV spots to pay the loan payments.

IV. Adjournment

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember Sharp. All voting aye, motion carried.
