**I. Second reading of an Ordinance establishing the city of Williamsburg Property Tax Rate for the year 2011.**

Mrs. Greta Price, City Attorney read the second reading of an Ordinance establishing the City of Williamsburg Property Tax Rate for the Year 2011.

The rate on real property will be .2600 cents per \$100 dollar valuation, Personal Property including automobiles will be .3586 cents per \$100 dollar valuation. Any city taxes unpaid as of January 1, 2012 shall be assessed a penalty of Ten (10) percent, as well as interest at the rate of six (6) percent until paid.
