**III. First reading of an Ordinance adopting the City of Williamsburg Tax Rate for the year 2012**

Greta Price, City Attorney read the first of an Ordinance adopting the City of Williamsburg's Tax Rate for the year 2012.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Williamsburg, Kentucky, the 2012 tax rate for Real Property shall be .2710 cents per \$100 dollar valuation. Personal Property including automobiles shall be .3441 cents per \$100 dollar valuation.

Any city property taxes unpaid as of January 1, 2013 shall be assessed a penalty of ten (10) percent, as well as interest at the rate of six (6) percent until paid.
